

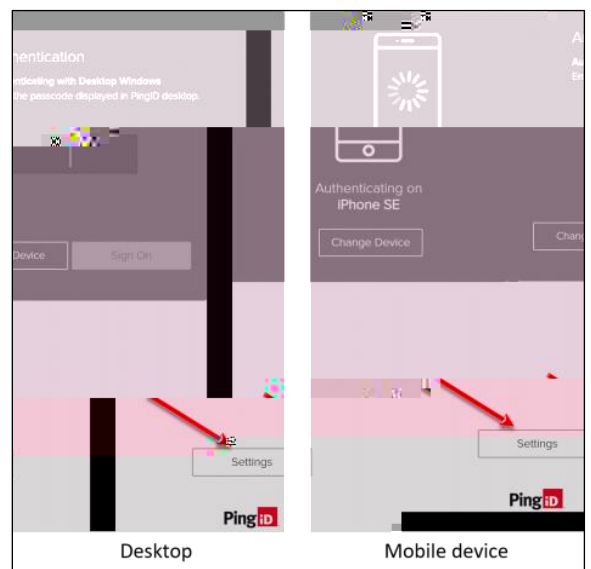
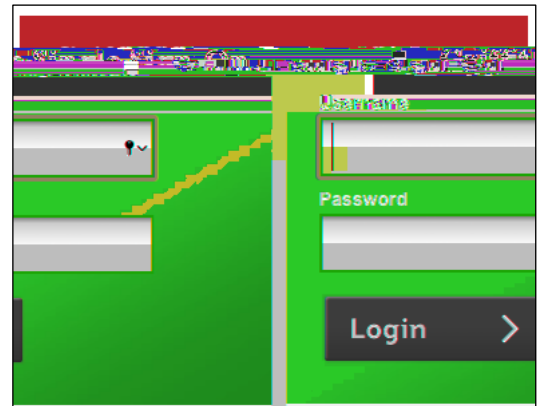
Introduction

Multi-factor authentication (MFA) is a way to ensure our accounts are highly-secured with multiple layers of security. PingID is the tool Griffith uses to enable MFA. This guide will show you how to install PingID on an additional Android device.


Step 1: Add your additional device

When the Authentication screen opens, select **Settings**. You will see a similar screen as below depending on the device that you have previously set up with MFA.

The **My Devices** page will open and show the devices you currently have paired with your PingID account. To set up an additional device, select **+Add**.



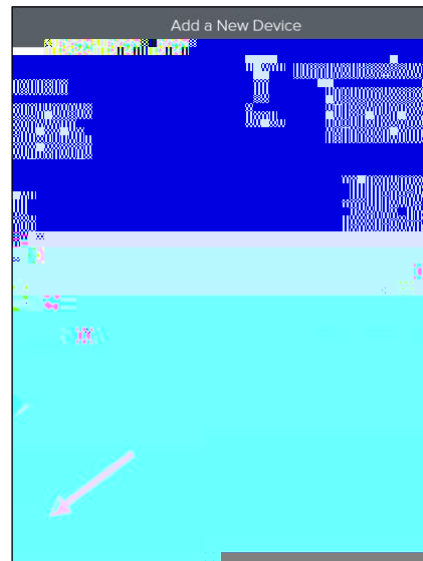
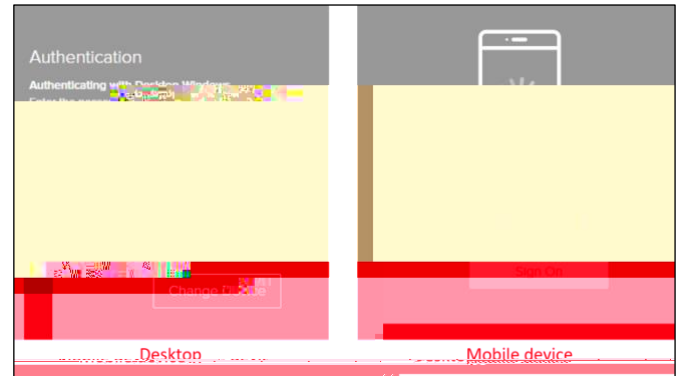
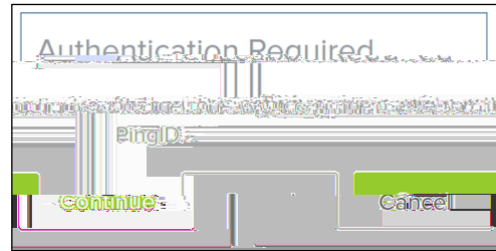
 Select **Continue**.

Step 2: Change your primary device

1 To make your newly added device your primary (default) one, move the slider bar to **on** (green) in the primary column.

If you have more than one of a particular device (e.g. two desktops registered) you will need to give each device a nickname to identify them (e.g. 'Desktop Work' and 'Desktop Home').
